

Faculty Senate Aggie Spirit Award

The Faculty Senate Aggie Spirit Award was established by a resolution at the February 12, 2001 Faculty Senate meeting. Guidelines for the Senate Aggie Spirit Awards are as follows.

I. Eligibility. Eligibility shall be based on the stated intent of the Faculty Senate to recognize outstanding courage and determination in the face of adversity while attending Texas A&M University. "Adversity" should be broadly interpreted; adversity might arise from a temporary or permanent physical, mental, or emotional condition, family circumstances, or a variety of other factors.

2. Nominations. Nominations will be submitted to the Faculty Senate Office. Because some potential candidates may prefer not to be considered, nominees will be offered the opportunity to decline the nomination before selections are made.

3. Selection. The Faculty Senate Committee on Committees (with the addition of a Student Government representative and a Student Senate representative) will serve as the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will recommend one or two individuals to the Executive Committee.

4. Award. The Award shall consist of a framed certificate signed by the Speaker of the Faculty Senate and the Chair of the Selection Committee and a monetary award (amount dependent on funds available). Awards will be made at the May meeting of the Faculty Senate, or at the first meeting of the Senate after the beginning of the fall term.
