Rationale for Proposal

Course changes made by recommendation of Museum Studies Executive Board. Specifically, the MAST additions will allow TAMUG students pursuing the minor to take courses approved for inclusion without needing them to all be added through adjustments. Removal of the ARCH 246 is due to a change in that course which resulted in the number being lowered to 200-level, it is no longer usable by students moving forward. Students will now have to take the cross-listed MAST 220/MUST 221 as a prerequisite for ANTH 421. This course better prepares students for ANTH 421 and can be taken earlier in a student's career to give them a better understanding of the field and the program and to enable them to tailor their curriculum.
