Rationale for Proposal

Updated to reflect new ICD and CD requirements. Adding newly created UG courses as options for degree requirements for the "Society focus courses", ANTH 370, SOCI 211, 302, 308, SOCI/WGST 310, SOCI 311, 312, 313, SOCI/WGST 315, 316, SOCI/SPMT 319, SOCI 322, SOCI/AFST 323, SOCI/RELS 326, SOCI 328, SOCI/WGST 332, SOCI 335, 403, SOCI/RPTS 404, SOCI 408, 411, 412, 415, 419, 423, 425, and 426; for "Law, Regulation and Policy focus courses," POLS 223, SOCI 338, and SOCI/WGST 410. For the "Ethics focus courses," PHIL 382 is added as an option, though students cannot choose both PHIL 382 and PHIL 482 to fulfill the 6 hour "Ethics focus" requirement. Also, we are allowing students to use upper division foreign language credits (in addition to the 14 hours already required for the BA) as options for "Experiential component and supplemental studies" courses. These include language instruction courses and courses taught in the target language.
