Additional information **Two courses, Internal Medicine (OMFS 620) and Physical Diagnosis (OMFS 615) were combined into one course, Internal Medicine and Physical Diagnosis (OMFS 625). The combining of these course streamlines the materials covered while still maintaining all accreditation requirements. To make up for this loss of an hour, an extra hour of research (ENDO 691) was added to the curriculum. The extra hour of research allows the students more time to work on their research requirement.**
