### Rationale for Proposal

**Added proposed degree evaluation for the CD change** We are requesting the creation of a new program dual program in order to correct a problem with assignment of our 5-year Professional Program in Accounting (PPA) students to degree and major codes in Compass. Our students in the PPA program have traditionally received a BBA in Accounting degree and a MS degree in the field that they choose (e.g. Finance, MIS, Accounting, Entrepreneurship, etc.). In 2015, the Finance Department changed their degree programs to include a two-year degree that was an M.S. in Finance. At the same time, they created a new program titled Masters in Financial Management which would be the new degree for students on in the PPA program who are accepted into the finance track. This was done to differentiate the two programs. There were no changes to the coursework that was required of our PPA students. We understood that this was to be a change in the name of the degree only. The problem was that when this was done, an error was made in processing the paperwork and even though there was no change in the

coursework, the fact that the name no longer includes "M.S." means that these students can no longer use the YR5 code in Compass. This is the first year that we will have students graduate with a Master of Financial Management degree. Due to the error in Compass, we are not able to properly assign these students to a code. This has implications for our students who are graduating in May 2017. Going forward, we also need to create a code that can be associated with our PPA finance track students so that we will not continue to have this problem in the future. In summary, we are requesting the creation of a new degree program to accommodate coding within the Compass system to correct an error made during the creation of the new finance programs in 2015. We have not made any changes to coursework or requirements for our students. Our request is simply to create the appropriate structures so that our students can be tracked and apply for graduation within the constraints of the system.

Also the number of General Electives in the evaluation sum to 11 hours, however the catalog list 12 hours. I narrowed the discrepancy to the listing of ACCT 322 (1 hr) in the catalog. I believe ACCT 322 may have been added in error because ACTT 322 is not listed in the degree evaluation but ACCT 321 (2 hrs) is. If ACCT 321 is required, it needs to be added to the plan of study table and the general elective hours adjusted. 2) MGMT 643 is listed on the evaluation ( Rule A Supporting Coursework) but it not listed in the Catalog.
