Rationale for Proposal

Attached proposed degree evaluation for the CD requirements Addition of the BBA/MS program in CARS. Undergraduate program code identifying this program is BBA-ACCT-YR5. The Master of Science in Entrepreneurial Leadership (MS-ENLD) was created specifically for the Professional Program in accounting students at Mays Business School. This program has already been approved, however, it was not originally linked to the undergraduate BBA-ACCT-YR5 degree. In order for PPA students to be enrolled in the correct graduate program and receive the correct MS degree, we need the MS-ENLD degree to link to the BBA-ACCT-YR5 degree program. This will be a five-year dual degree program like all other PPA degrees. The BBA-ACCT-YR5 students in this program used to graduate with a MS-MGMT degree, however, this degree now goes to our students in our newly created MS Business degree program. Therefore, the MGMT department had to create a new MS program specifically for PPA students since they could no longer use the MS-MGMT degree code. This is when the MS-ENLD degree was created. The MS-ENLD program has already been approved, but it needs to be linked to the BBA-ACCT-YR5 program so that students can be admitted to graduate school and graduate with this new degree.

Reviewer Comments **Angel Mario Carrizales (carri1214) (11/01/18 2:38 pm):** Rollback: Please address the following. 1) ACCT 322 is listed in the plan of study table (3rd year, Spring), but not in the degree evaluation. Also the number of General Electives in the evaluation sum to 11 hours, however the catalog list 12 hours. I narrowed the discrepancy to the listing of ACCT 322 (1 hr) in the catalog. I believe ACCT 322 may have been added in error because ACTT 322 is not listed in the degree evaluation but ACCT 321 (2 hrs) is. If ACCT 321 is required, it needs to be added to the plan of study table and the general elective hours adjusted. 2) MGMT 643 is listed on the evaluation (Rule A Supporting Coursework) but it not listed in the Catalog.
