Students should plan a program of study in consultation with one of the department's undergraduate advisors.

A minimum of 33 hours in history may be applied to the degree. Students must take not less than 15 credit hours at upper level for history residency requirement. A grade of C or higher is required for a course to be counted in the major field. A student must complete not less than 18 hours of coursework in history at Texas A&M University.

Minor Field of Study

All history majors are encouraged to select a minor field of study from departments or divisions within or outside of the College of Liberal Arts or in a particular area of interest (as in the case of interdisciplinary minors or career opportunity minors). The minor will consist of a minimum of 15 hours of coursework, as defined by the minor department. A grade of C or higher is required for a course to be counted in the minor field. [Interdisciplinary minors](#) such as Women's and Gender Studies, Africana Studies, Classical Studies, Religious Studies, Film Studies, Latina/o and Mexican American Studies, and Business have specific requirements; students should consult undergraduate advisors in these areas of study. A second major may substitute for the minor. Courses used to meet the minor requirements may not be used in the major. See also the statement on "Minor Field of Study" under the [general requirements](#) of the College of Liberal Arts.

Angel Mario Carrizales (carri1214) (11/26/18 9:17 am): Edits made to conform to catalog style guidelines.
Angel Mario Carrizales (carri1214) (11/26/18 10:03 am): Moving forward, however, the catalog program requirements and the degree evaluation do not match. The degree evaluation is set up to allow 6 hours of any approved mathematics core courses. The catalog program requirements list 3 hours of approved mathematics core courses and 3 hours of a select one of the following statement ('MATH course,' PHIL 240, PHIL 341, and PHIL 342.) PHIL 341 and PHIL 342 are not approved mathematics core courses. These courses should be

removed from the catalog program requirements. The "MATH course" text links to all mathematics courses (e.g., MATH 100-499.) Also, the degree evaluation does not explicitly list PHIL 240. Is PHIL 240 required for the degree or is a recommended course? Edits to the catalog program requirements or the degree evaluation are needed to ensure that we are enforcing what the department of History requires for the degree.
