If it can be done in this round of approvals, great. If not, I can resubmit it once this workflow is completed. All I'm doing is adding 1.5 hours of AEGD 604 (Practice Management I) and deleting PROS 642 (Advanced TMD and Occlusal Concepts and Treatments). We are actually just swapping these two courses between the MS and Certificate so the students finish their MS requirements a semester earlier. This allows them to be able to defend their thesis one semester earlier.</p>
